Save the Date: March 7 Municipal Election

On March 7, 2017, there will be a municipal election in Los Angeles County. Culver City voters will have four items to consider on the ballot in this election:

Seat 2 on the Board of Trustees for Los Angeles Community College District
Seat 4 on the Board of Trustees for Los Angeles Community College District
Seat 6 on the Board of Trustees for Los Angeles Community College District
Los Angeles County Measure H (a sales tax measure to fund homeless services and prevention), also known as "Los Angeles County Plan to Prevent and Combat Homelessness"

The specific services and programs to be funded by Measure H would comply with the "Approved Strategies to Combat Homelessness," which is included in the Los Angeles County Homeless Initiative and was approved by the Los Angeles County Board of Supervisors on February 9, 2016. At the February 13, 2017 City Council meeting, the City Council unanimously adopted a position to support Measure H. Interested voters can visit the City Clerk's website to learn more about this election, the voting process for the March 7 election, and review additional information about Measure H.
