Culver City has long been recognized for its diverse parks, responsive city services, and proactive approach to community challenges. To sustain these critical services and continue providing the high-quality amenities our residents expect, Culver City is proposing a 0.25% sales tax increase. This measure aims to address the city's structural budget deficit, accommodate the rising cost of living, and ensure the future stability of our budget, especially given our obligations for employee pensions.

It's important to act now. Los Angeles County and the Los Angeles Metropolitan Transportation Authority (Metro) are facing significant budget deficits and could likely seek sales tax increases that would be paid by Culver City residents. If these agencies act first, Culver City would reach the allowable sales tax cap, but the city wouldn't receive the additional revenue.

By approving the 0.25% sales tax increase, which is estimated to yield up to \$5 - 6 million a year, Culver City ensures that 100% of the revenue generated remains within the city, supporting vital services like affordable housing, homelessness initiatives, street and sidewalk maintenance, public safety, youth and senior programs, and more.

By investing in our community today, we can preserve the quality of life that makes Culver City a desirable place to live, work, play, and thrive.
